### Scholarship Criteria – SMPS Oregon

Only the cost of registration will be covered. Candidates are responsible for paying their own travel, lodging and meals related expenditures. The SMPS Oregon Executive Committee at its discretion, will determine who and the number of award winners each year. The Committee targets between 2-3 winners each year, but this is dependent on the number of entries and financial strength of the chapter at the time of submission.

### JUDGING CRITERIA

Candidates should be able to demonstrate their commitment to their career as an A/E/C marketer through professional development activities, participation in the SMPS Oregon Chapter, and the contributions they have made to their firm in their current position.

### SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Completed scholarship application section 2 (page 3)
- A copy of your professional resume – must include your current contact information and dates of employment (2-page maximum)
- Application Statements (2-page maximum) which describes:
  1. Your involvement in professional services marketing and responsibilities in your current position
  2. Describe how you anticipate this program will assist you in either maintaining or improving your current job skills, or enable you to work toward changing your career path within the A/E/C industry
  3. Your SMPS Oregon Chapter engagement and level of active involvement within the last five years (committees, roundtables, mentorship, event attendance, etc.)
  4. How SMPS has benefited you both personally and professionally
  5. Statement on how you will bring back what you learned from this certificate program and share with your local SMPS Chapter. (i.e. blog post, social media post, guest speaker at a roundtable or SMPSTalks, etc.)
